## Blended Scotch Whisky

---

**Grant's Ale Cask Blended Scotch Whisky** 40% £4

*A blended whisky from the independent and family owned William Grant & Son's. After the whiskies have been blended this has been further aged in ex beer barrels to add a creamy malt character.*

**Monkey Shoulder Vatted Malt Whisky** 40% £4.50

*Made by William Grant & Sons, using only whisky from their 3 malt distilleries: Glenfiddich, Balvenie & Kininvie. Rich vanilla notes mingle with spice and orange zest influence from sherry casks.*

**Compass Box Great King Street Artist Blend** 40% £5.50

*A fantastic blend from one of the leading blenders in the industry. This focusses on some of the best Highland single malts with lots of spice and subtle smoke.*

**Elements of Islay 'Peat', Islay Blended Whisky** 45% £6.50

*A great introduction to Islay whiskies, with this blend only comprising of single malts from the island off Scotland's West coast. Well balanced notes of fruit, spice and smoke.*

## Single Malt Scotch Whisky

---

**Auchentoshan American Oak** £5.50  
40%, Glasgow, Lowland

*Triple distilled for smoothness and aged only in first fill ex-bourbon barrels, this whisky brings lots of vanilla sweetness and ripe fruits.*

**Royal Lochnager 12 Year Old** £5.50  
40%, Balmoral, Highland

*A favourite of Queen Victoria & Prince Albert from whom it received its Royal warrant. Lochnager is a major component of Johnnie Walker blends, with wonderful richness and toffee notes.*

**Tomatin Cu Bocan** £5.50  
46%, Tomatin, Highland

*In the 70's, Tomatin were producing more whisky than any other in Scotland until they sadly went bust. Thankfully now back in business, Cu Bocan is a lightly peated release with heavy sherry influences and coffee notes.*

**Clynelish 14 Year Old** £6  
46%, Brora, Highland

*The modern Clynelish distillery was built in 1968 next door to what became the Brora distillery that was closed in 1983. Clynelish is a major component for many blends with a wonderful balance of smoke, orange peel and briny influence from the North Sea.*

**Mannochmore 12 Year Old** £7  
43%, Elgin, Speyside

*The only official bottling from the Mannochmore distillery as most of its whisky is used in blends. A delicate and fragrant whisky with a great freshness.*

**Glenfarclas 15 Year Old** £7.50  
46%, Ballindalloch, Speyside

*One of the few remaining family owned distilleries, founded in 1836 and now in its 6th generation. A hugely well respected example of Speyside whisky from one of its best distillers. Aged solely in sherry casks, with no colouring or filtration, a truly exceptional whisky.*

**Balvenie 14 Year Old Caribbean Cask** £7.50  
43%, Dufftown, Speyside

*One of the few distilleries in Scotland to still grow and malt some of their own barley. This has been aged in traditional casks before being finished in ex Caribbean Rum casks. A perfect marriage of vanilla and honey with pineapple and caramel from the rum.*

**Macallan 12 Year Old Fine Oak** £7.50  
40%, Aberlour, Speyside

*One of the first legally licensed distilleries, and one of the most collected whiskies in the world. Aged in both ex bourbon and sherry casks, this carries lots of dried fruits and caramel notes.*

**Springbank 10 Year Old** £6  
46%, Campbeltown

*One of only 2 distilleries to do the entire process from malting to bottling on site. Springbank distil their spirit unusually 2 and a half times and then aged in both ex bourbon and sherry casks. Light smoke with nuttiness and salty influences from the sea.*

**Longrow Peated** £6  
46%, Campbeltown

*Made at the Springbank distillery, this is a highly peated whisky, where the malt has been slowly dried for 110 hours. As a result the smoke is rich but not overpowering coupled with flavours of honey and coffee.*

**Port Askaig 8 Year Old** £6  
45.8%, Islay

*An 8 year old whisky from an undisclosed Islay distillery. A warming and smoky whisky, with notes of liquorice, salt and pepper.*

**Bruichladdich Islay Barley 2009** £7  
50%, Bruichladdich, Islay

*Bruichladdich have a long heritage but firmly look to the future. They believe in terroir and the locality of the barley they use, all the barley in this whisky was grown on Islay and you can even trace the barley to the exact field using the code on the bottle. No peat is used and the result is a malty and fruity dram.*

**Port Charlotte Scottish Barley** £7  
50%, Bruichladdich, Islay

*Port Charlotte is the name given to Bruichladdich's peated whiskies. This heavily peated bottling has been made from 100% Scottish grown barley. An elegant and floral whisky with classic peat characteristics.*

**Kilchoman Machir Bay 2016** £7  
46%, Kilchoman, Islay

*Established in 2005 and becoming the first new distillery on the island for 124 years! Kilchoman wanted to bring back the idea of farm distilling, they grow their own barley, and carry out all other processes on site. A peaty whisky mingled with lemon and vanilla.*

**The Arran Malt Cask Finishes: Sauternes** £6.50  
50%, Isle of Arran

*The only distillery on the Isle of Arran and established in 1994. In that relatively short space of time they have won numerous prestigious awards and accolades. This has been aged for approximately 8 years in traditional casks before being finished in Bordeaux Sauternes wine barrels. A complex and full bodied whisky, with sweet and sticky honey, and fresh apricot.*

## American Whiskey

---

**Evan Williams Extra Aged Straight Bourbon** £4  
43%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*Made by the family owned Heaven Hill distillers, and one of the most popular Bourbons in the USA. Evan Williams is aged for between 4-5 years, longer than the required 2 years for 'Straight' bourbon. Lots of caramel and vanilla, with some gentle spice.*

**Mellow Corn, Straight Corn Whiskey** £4.50  
50%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*Made by Heaven Hill since 1945, keeping alive the history of Corn Whiskey, and is the only one still being made. Corn whiskey has to be minimum 81% corn and aged in second hand oak barrels. Mellow Corn has been aged for over 4 years, and has lots of sweet corn character with nutty and caramel notes.*

**Smooth Ambler 8 Year Old, Single Barrel Bourbon Whiskey** £5  
50.6%, Greenbrier County, West Virginia

*A special single barrel bottling just for our group of bars in London. This barrel has been specially selected by us, and we have every bottle from it! It has been bottled at barrel strength, aged for 8 years and is rich in rye spice and rich caramel. A whiskey to savour.*

**Larceny 92 Proof, Straight Bourbon Whiskey** £5.50  
46%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*A small batch bourbon made by Heaven Hill, using wheat as it's secondary grain alongside corn. The result is a smooth and well rounded bourbon.*

**Rittenhouse Rye, Bottled-In-Bond Rye Whiskey** £5.50  
50%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*One of the leading and best regarded Rye Whiskeys, which Heaven Hill continued to make despite Rye falling out of popularity over the last few decades. This is bottled in bond which means it is the product of a single distillery, in a single season in a single year, aged for at least 4 years, with minimum 50% alcohol and no colouring or flavouring added. Lots of spice and pepper, perfect alongside a beer.*

**Evan Williams Single Barrel 2004** £6  
43.3%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*A yearly single barrel release from Heaven Hill, with each barrel personally selected by head distillers Craig & Parker Beam. Being aged for 9 years has allowed the whiskey to develop intense vanilla flavours alongside cinnamon and mint notes.*

**Basil Hayden's, Straight Bourbon Whiskey** £6  
40%, Frankfort, Kentucky

*Named in honour of one of the USA's pioneering distillers in the early years of the country. Basil Hayden uses a high proportion of rye as it's secondary grain alongside barley, and is aged for 8 years. A spicy bourbon, with cinnamon and pepper alongside caramel and vanilla.*

**Elijah Craig 12 Year Old, Straight Bourbon Whiskey** £6  
47%, Bardstown, Kentucky

*Another bourbon named in honour of one of America's whiskey pioneers, Elijah Craig is made by Heaven Hill, with the same grain recipe as Evan Williams Extra Aged, but spending a minimum of 12 years aging in barrels, before being bottled in small batches. Lots of vanilla, caramel and light spice.*

**N.Y. Distilling Ragtime Rye, Straight Rye Whiskey** £6.50  
45.2%, Brooklyn, New York

*A fantastic Rye Whiskey from one of the leading distillers in the US craft distilling boom. All the Rye is grown within NY state, aged in full size barrels for over 3 years. Lots of spice alongside orange and dark berry fruits.*

**Sonoma County Distilling Co. Sonoma Rye** £7  
49%, Sonoma, California

*Very small batch rye spirit, uniquely made using 100% rye, and using direct fire heated pot stills. It is then aged in new American oak barrels before being finished in old barrels to mellow. Lots of spice and rich character from the rye, alongside orange and oak characteristics.*

**Jack Daniel's Single Barrel Select, Tennessee Whiskey** £7.50  
45%, Lynchburg, Tennessee

*Bottled from selected single barrels of the famous Tennessee Whiskey, the result is a richer and spicier whiskey than the standard Jack Daniel's, with less sweetness.*

**Michter's US\*1 Unblended American Whiskey** £8  
41.7%, Louisville, Kentucky

*Hailing from one of the oldest distilleries in the USA, and making a huge comeback. This follows the same process as their bourbon, but that it has been aged in second use barrels, which is why it can no longer be labelled as bourbon. A wonderfully fruity whisky, with notes of apple and fresh herbs.*

**Westland Sherry Wood Single Malt Whiskey** £10  
46%, Seattle, Washington

*A unique American Whiskey distillery, in that they don't make bourbon, instead all their whiskies are single malts. Meaning they are made from malted barley and use various casks, old and new. For this release they use a mixture of 5 different types of malted barley, and casks that previously held Oloroso and Pedro Ximénez Sherry. Lots of rich raisin and cherry flavours, with a malty backbone and hint of smoke.*

**Hudson Four Grain Bourbon Whiskey** £11  
46%, Gardiner, New York

*Made on the Tuthilltown Distillery in New York state, which was the first legally licensed distillery in the state since prohibition. This uses 4 grains: corn, rye, wheat and barley, all fermented as whole grains. The result is a smooth and easy sipping whiskey, with layered flavours of praline and vanilla.*

## Irish Whiskey

**Teeling Small Batch Irish Whiskey**  
46%, Dublin

*The Teeling family have a long history in Irish whiskey stretching back to the 1700's, and it was Jack Teeling who rekindled that history with the launch of the Teeling Whiskey Company in 2012, becoming Ireland's leading independent whiskey producer. This is a blend of both malt and grain whiskies aged for between 4 to 7 years, which are then finished in ex rum barrels adding sweet molasses flavours alongside apple and vanilla.*

**West Cork 10 Year Old Single Malt Irish Whiskey** £5  
40%, Cork

*The most southerly distillery in Ireland, which triple distils all of it's whiskey in pot stills, uses only Irish grown barley, malts some of it's own barley on site, and uses natural spring water in all of their processes. A lot of the equipment at the distillery was also hand built by the team working there. Chocolate and vanilla notes with subtle spice.*

## Japanese Whisky

---

**Nikka All Malt, Blended Malt Whisky**  
40%, Hokkaido

*One of the leading lights of Japanese Whisky, Nikka was founded by the father of Japanese Whisky Masataka Taketsuru. Taketsuru learnt about whisky in Scotland, and once he returned to Japan put what he learnt to use. First working for Suntory, before in 1934 setting up the Nikka Yoichi distillery in a climate very similar to that of Scotland. This whisky is a blend of single malts created at both of their distilleries in Japan and is a perfect introduction to Japanese whisky, with lovely light smoke and dried fruit.*

**Suntory Old Whisky**  
43%, Osaka

*Suntory was founded in 1899 as an importer and distributor of wine in Japan, gradually creating their own products until in 1923 with the help of Masataka Taketsuru established the Yamazaki distillery, the first Japanese whisky distillery. Old Whisky is a blend of whiskies created at their 2 single malt distilleries: Yamazaki & Hakushu. Before Single Malts grew in popularity this was the staple of Japanese whisky, rich and spicy, perfect for sipping.*

**Nikka Coffey Malt Whisky**  
45%, Sendai

£8

*In 1969 Nikka opened their second distillery 'Miyagikyo' in Sendai, after Masataka Taketsuru accidentally stumbled on the location and thought it would be a perfect place to make whisky. Particularly to make softer and more restrained whiskies to complement the big, smoky whiskies of the Yoichi distillery. This has been distilled on ancient 'Coffey' stills from the 19th century, creating a light and fragrant spirit, with light spice and brown sugar.*

**The Hakushu Single Malt Whisky Distillers Reserve** £8  
43%, Chubu

*Hakushu in Japanese means applause, and is a wonderful whisky created deep in a volcanic, temperate rain forest surrounded by green trees and foliage. A blend of whiskies from the distillery, this is a perfect showcase of what Hakushu is about with smoke and oak mixing with light mint and fresh grass.*

## World Whisky

---

**Mackmyra Brukswhisky, The Swedish Whisky**  
41.4%, Sweden

*Mackmyra was established in 1999 by 8 friends who questioned why there were no whisky distilleries in Sweden so set about to change that. Brukswhisky is their core whisky, aged in a mixture of ex bourbon and sherry barrels but also Swedish oak barrels. The result is a light and fragrant whisky, with slight hints of smoke and green fruit.*

**Starward New World Malt Whisky**  
43%, Australia

£7.50

*Made using 100% Australian malted barley, then mostly aged in ex Australian fortified wine barrels which have been re-coopered and charred. A uniquely 'New World' whisky, with rich intensity from the wine barrels, backed up with malt and spice.*

**Kavalan Single Malt Whisky**  
40%, Taiwan

£9

*Since launching in 2008 Kavalan have been making huge waves in the whisky World with their continually impressive releases. In 2011 they won Best in Class at the International Wine & Spirit Competition, along with a host of other awards along the way. A rich and oaky whisky, with port and sherry influences alongside tropical fruits and vanilla.*
